



Are you looking for a career working in a salon, resort or spa? Would you like to become a Licensed Aesthetician, working with clients on specialized skin care and treatment, waxing and facials? This 300-hour program will train you on skin care science and practical hands-on skills required to take the Massachusetts Licensed Aesthetician exam.

This is a two-semester program --The practical hands-on part of this program takes place in the Spring Semester. You will focus on the use of electrical aesthetic equipment, high frequency, massage, aromatherapy, clinical practice, face treatment procedures, and record keeping. You will also learn how to stage a successful spa business plan. In Fall you will learn theory and concentrate on anatomy, physiology, diseases and disorders of the skin, cosmetic chemical ingredients, product knowledge, sterilization, bacteriology, laws, ethics and massage relaxation

techniques. Both semesters must be successfully completed to qualify to sit for the Aesthetician's License Exam.

Tuition includes texts and the State Exam Book. The total cost for this two-semester program is \$3,998. Tuition for each semester is \$1,999. Pay each semester in full before the first class and receive a 10% discount. Your instructor will provide a list of no-class dates.



Accounting Basics

This introduction to the basics of financial accounting and bookkeeping will include common topics relating to accounting. Assets, liabilities, and equity and how they relate to GAAP (Generally Accepted Accounting Practices) will be discussed. We will review basic accounting statements, including balance sheets, income statement and profit and loss. This is a great class to take before the QuickBooks computer class.
