Hybrid, Live/Virtual, Online Self-Paced - What does that mean?

Hybrid Courses

We offer two types of hybrid courses. Both types have two components:





Live/Virtual: Some hybrid courses have a live/virtual component. Students meet with a live instructor on a virtual platform, and are able to interact with the instructor and others attending the class. Students will

receive a Zoom invitation link by email in advance of the live/virtual class. The second part of the class is conducted in person at Keefe Tech.





Self-Paced: Other hybrid courses have a self-paced component. This means that students will receive access to an interactive website where they will complete classwork on their own schedule. However, all work

must be completed in advance of the in-person sessions. In-person classes meet at Keefe Tech.



Live/Virtual Courses - These courses are conducted entirely on Zoom. A live instructor will teach the class.

Students will be able to interact with the instructor and others attending the class. Students will receive a Zoom invitation link by email in advance of class.



Online Self-Paced - Students complete these courses on their own schedule. Please be aware that

students will have access to these courses for a limited number of months. Upon registration, students will receive access to an interactive website where they will complete classwork on their own.




