

Emergency Medical Technician, EMT Certification Training Program - Hybrid Format

EMT basics are the foundation of pre-hospital emergency medical care. Only a person licensed by the Massachusetts Board of Building Regulations and Standards may supervise the construction and renovation of all one and two family dwellings and all buildings containing less than 35,000 cubic feet of enclosed space. This class will help you prepare for your Massachusetts Construction Supervisors unrestricted license exam. This course requires students to devote a significant amount of time familiarizing themselves with the building code materials and methods of preparation for the exam. Through this learning method, students will be able to retain the process of the system in order to find the answers to the test questions that will be presented. In addition to class time, students will be expected to work on practice exams and to read 6-8 hours per week. A score of 70% is required to successfully pass the state exam.
