

- 4. Walk-in Registrations: Please see office hours above.

Forms of Payment: We accept Cash, MasterCard, Visa, Checks, Money Orders, & Organization Purchase Orders. Refunds by check (for cash and check payments) may take up to four weeks to reach you.

Age Requirement for Registration: The

required minimum age is 18 for Keefe at Night Programs. The New York/Broadway trip and virtual music courses are open to children 13 years of age and up.
