This semester the vast majority of classes will take place at Keefe Tech, but we will continue to offer virtual and hybrid courses. In addition a few courses will take place at offsite locations.





Our 4-year Tier Program fulfills the required Tier Code & Theory portion of training for students wishing to become Massachusetts Journeyman Plumbers. Each Tier covers the state requirements for licensure.

Enrollment is open to non-licensed plumbing apprentices in Tier 1 ONLY. Students wanting to enroll in Tiers 2, 3, 4 & 5 must hold a current Massachusetts apprenticeship license and have successfully completed the previous tier.

With the exception of Tier 1 (see above), classes are open only to current apprentices licensed as a Massachusetts Plumbing Apprentice. Participants in the 5-Tier system are required to complete 550 classroom hours (110 hours per Tier) and 6800 apprenticeship work hours (1700 hours per work year) to qualify to take the Journeyman Plumber Test.




